

Where's the coloring book?!!!

Coloring books are no longer just for the kids. In fact, adult coloring books are all the rage right now. "Coloring definitely has therapeutic potential to reduce anxiety, create focus or bring about more mindfulness," says Marygrace Berberian, a certified art therapist at NYU. Groundbreaking research in 2005 proved anxiety levels dropped when subjects colored mandalas, which are round frames with geometric patterns inside. Just like meditation, coloring also allows us to switch off our brains from other thoughts and focus only on the moment, helping to alleviate free-floating anxiety.

So have some fun and color!
