Rhubarb Dream Bars



Crust: Mix 2 cups of flour,
3/4 cup of powdered sugar,
1 cup of butter.

Press into a 9x13 pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes.

Filling: Combine 4 eggs,
2 cups of sugar,
1/4 cup of flour, and
1/2 tsp of salt.

Fold in 4 cups of chopped rhubarb.

Pour over baked crust. Bake at 350 degrees
for 40-55 minutes until set and brown on edges.
