RUMMAGE SALES

The Housing Authority permits rummage sales under the guidelines listed below. According to your lease, "Legal profit-making activities incidental to the residential use may be permitted after the Owner's written consent is obtained".



Please follow these guidelines, and good luck with your sale!

- 1. The Housing Authority should be notified in writing at least 10 days prior to the sale, including **date and location** (example garage)
- 2. The sale needs to be supervised at all times to ensure that neighbor children are not presented with an opportunity to get hurt.
- 3. The sale of weapons, hazardous material, drugs or medications, stolen items, or items that could result in serious harm is prohibited.
- 4. A maximum of two sales per 12 month period is permitted.
- 5. A sale should not last for more than 4 days.
- 6. Your yard needs to be fully picked up within 24 hours of the sale concluding.
- 7. If your unit has a garage, it should continue to meet cleanliness and safety expectations at all times during and after the sale.
- 8. Parking should be restricted to the street. Parking in fire lanes or other resident driveways is prohibited.
