## Dear FSS participants,

### BACK TO SCHOOL FAIR:

Oshkosh's annual Back to School Fair which is organized by 35 local organizations including the Oshkosh/Winnebago County Housing Authority, took place 8/11/2016 at Oaklawn Elementary School. Over 1,000 kids in the community were provided with all the supplies they will need for school this fall, from backpacks and clothing to hygiene products and even haircuts. For the first time this year, we were also able to provide shoes to kids in need. Thank you to the US Venture/Schmidt Family Foundation for providing funding for shoes. Working with Shopko stores, we were able to get enough pairs of shoes for over 500 elementary kids this year! Please put this event on your calendar for next year if you would like school supplies or to volunteer.

### FSS GRADUATIONS:

Yahoo! FSS has 2 more graduations this August. During one participant's time with FSS she went from part time to full time employment. She attended the money conference, obtained a Rent Smart Certificate, met with FISC advisor to create a budget, updated her resume, and took several computer courses to advance her skills for a better job. She had attended homebuyer's education workshop and will be buying a home with her FSS escrow of **\$19,017.72** as a down payment along with the Homebuyer's Program assistance. The second FSS participant had established steady employment throughout her participation in the FSS program. She attended classes thru FVTC, attended counseling and doctor's appointments for her kids, met with Habitat for Humanity, increase her credit score to 644, paid off her collection bills, and attended FISC budgeting counseling. She now receives full insurance benefits through her employment. She will use her **\$20,462.57** escrow along with the Homebuyer's Program assistance for her down payment on her new home.

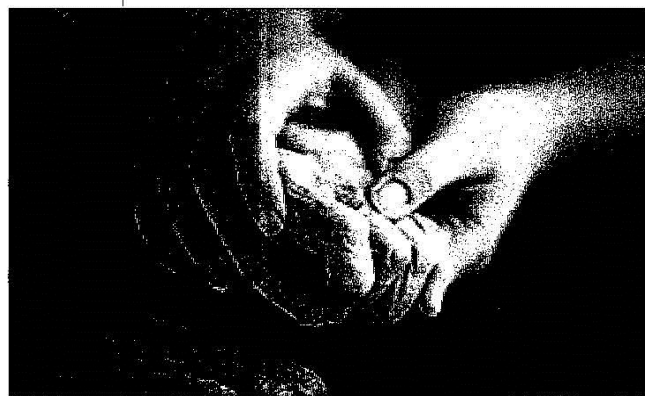

## **Driver's License Recovery**



Driver's license suspensions and revocations are a barrier to employment to many people in our community. Many jobs require a driver's license, and often, many workers commute long distances to their jobs. Legal Action of Wisconsin, Inc., aims to provide legal assistance to individuals who have active suspensions and/or revocations against their Wisconsin driver's licenses or against their ability to obtain a Wisconsin driver's license.

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Meet Legal Action of Wisconsin, Inc.'s eligibility criteria
- Have a suspended or revoked Wisconsin Class D driver's license, or suspended or revoked privilege to obtain a Wisconsin Class D driver's license
- Be a Winnebago County resident and at least 18 years old
- Be under 200% of the federal poverty level
- Have no pending charge for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) and no current revocation for OWI
- Have completed DMV written/knowledge test within past 12 months if the person hasn't had a valid driver's license in the past 8 years

Some examples of suspensions and revocations that Legal Action of Wisconsin, Inc., in Oshkosh, may assist with include but are not limited to the following:

- Failure to Pay a Forfeiture
- Demerit Points
- Operating While Suspended/Revoked

NOTE: In addition to the eligibility criteria listed above, many factors are considered to determine whether a case will be accepted for representation. These factors include but may not be limited to whether or not there is a legal conflict, staff availability and resources, and legal merit.

## Chicken Bacon Florentine Fettuccine

Servings: 3-4

### INGREDIENTS

2 tablespoons olive oil  
2 chicken breasts, sliced thinly into strips  
5 ounces spinach  
1 cup tomatoes, diced  
8 strips bacon, cooked and finely chopped  
2 teaspoons salt  
2 teaspoons pepper  
2 cups milk  
12 ounces cooked fettuccine  
1 cup parmesan, shredded

### PREPARATION

1. Heat the oil in a pot over high heat.
2. Cook the chicken and let it brown a bit until no pink is showing.
3. Add the spinach, tomatoes, bacon, salt, and pepper, stirring until spinach is wilted.
4. Pour in the milk and bring to a boil.
5. Add the fettuccine, stirring until milk has reduced enough that it coats the pasta.
6. Sprinkle in the parmesan, mixing until the cheese is melted.
7. Serve!
