During January 2 through April of every year, anyone interested in help with their taxes can call the local Tax Assistance number at (920) 426-0150 to make an appointment for free tax preparation and filing through Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) or Tax Counseling for the Elderly (TCE) programs.

If your household earned less than \$66,000 in 2018, you can file both your federal and state returns for free online using MyFreeTaxes.com. This is the only free, national, online tax filing product offered by a nonprofit. 



1 cup ivory soap (powder)

1/2 cup washing soda

1/2 cup borax

Mix ingredients and store in sealed container. Use 1 tablespoon for light loads.
