

Flu Shot Clinic for Waite Rug Place Residents

There will be a flu shot clinic for Waite Rug Place residents on Thursday, October 8, 2020 from 11:00 AM - 12:30 PM in the Business Center/Library, which is located near the Waite Rug office on the first floor.

Registered Pharmacist Jenni Villeneuve will be here to administer flu and pneumonia shots to any interested residents.

Masks must be worn in all common areas of the building. Physical distancing and sanitary techniques will be followed during the flu shot clinic.

Absentee Ballot Process - General Election Tuesday, November 3, 2020

Absentee voting is available and no excuse is required. The last day to request an absentee ballot is 5 days before the election. Voted ballots must be received by 8pm on Election Day in order to be counted.

Who Can Request an Absentee Ballot?

Any qualified elector who registers to vote in Wisconsin is eligible to request an absentee ballot.

How to Request an Absentee Ballot

Online. You may request an absentee ballot online by visiting myvote.wi.gov and

EBT (Wisconsin Quest cards)

Manager's Corner

Knock n Go Food Delivery to Continue Beginning Tuesday, September 8th

Community members are coordinating knock n go delivery of food boxes (fresh fruit and vegetables, frozen meat and dry goods) to addresses of people in need in Oshkosh and Appleton for the next several months. Note: there will be <u>no</u> deliveries the week of August 31st. Food box deliveries take place every Tuesday and Thursday between 11 AM and noon. Some families ask for it once a week.

If you are interested in receiving a food box, let Bob or Jane know by noon on Monday for a Tuesday delivery or by noon on Wednesday for a Thursday delivery.

Lease renewal interviews

Office Staffing Schedules

Please be flexible with us, in regards to availability. My schedule will be very flexible for the month of September. There will be times that I am not available during day, but will be available in the evening. Jane will be back at the building beginning mid-September as well. I will do my best to put updated hours on the office door as I learn those schedules.

Wear Masks and Social Distance

The Housing Authority continues to require mask wearing and social distancing within the common areas of all Housing Authority owned properties. This includes all residents, all caregivers, all Housing Authority employees, all contractors and any visitors. This will remain in effect until further notice.

By Mail. Download the <u>application</u>, complete the form and mail it to your municipal clerk's office. The application must be received no later than 5pm on the Thursday before the election.

In Person. You may vote early in person – at the clerk's office or another site designated by the clerk. Dates and hours for early voting may vary, though it can begin no earlier than 14 days before the election and ends no later than the Sunday before the election. Please contact your <u>municipal clerk</u> for absentee voting hours.

If you have not previously provided a copy of your photo ID, photo ID must accompany your application. Military and permanent overseas voters do not need to provide a photo ID with their request.

Deadline for Returning Your Absentee Ballot

Your complete absentee ballot must be delivered no later than 8pm on Election Day. The US Postal Service recommends you mail your absentee ballot one week before Election Day to ensure it arrives in time. You may hand-deliver you absentee ballot to your polling place by 8pm on Election Day.

Permanent Absentee Ballot

Voters who are indefinitely confined, meaning they have a difficult time getting to the polls due to age, illness, infirmity, or disability, may request that a ballot be automatically sent to them for each election. Indefinitely confined voters do not need to provide a photo ID with their absentee ballot request. Voters on the permanent absentee ballot list must vote in each election or they will be dropped from the absentee ballot rolls.

What if you are in the hospital?

Each hospitalized voter can request a ballot (in writing), and the voter may appoint an agent to pick up the ballot from the hospitalized voter's clerk's office. If you know you will be in the hospital, request a regular absentee ballot in advance.
