## TRANSITIONAL JOBS PROGRAM

#### What is T)?

Transitional Jobs (T[) is an employment program that offers unemployed residents immediate work. T] is a program of Wisconsin's Department of Children and Families. The purpose of T] is to enhance employment opportunities for people who have difficulty entering and succeeding in the workforce. The T] employment strategy helps individuals overcome employment barriers and transition into work by using wage-paid, short-term employment that combines real work, skills training, education and supportive services. T] also offers (ob coaching, employability planning, life skills development, and limited vocational training, as well as (ob search assistance.

T) promotes self-sufficiency by providing time-limited, publicly funded, wage-based jobs in public, nonprofit, or for profit settings. The goal is to help eligible residents gain a footbold in the labor market with Jobs that are available in the public and private sectors. Tj's combination of training, work experience, case management, and supportive services will produce positive results for Green Bay and surrounding area job sockors and the employers who "bire" program participants.

## **Child Tax Credit**



Monthly Child Tax Credit Payments are Now Available for Families with Children

Monthly payments are available for families through December 2021:



\$300/month for each child under the age of 6



\$250/month for each child age 6-17

#### YES

You can still sign up to receive monthly payments from now until December 2021



If you sign up later in the year, your monthly payments will be larger to make up for missed months

#### YES

You will still be able to receive all current benefits such as SNAP, SSI, unemployment, Medicaid, HUD-Assisted Housing, or WIC

#### YES

You can receive your monthly checks by mail to your home, or deposited directly to your bank account



#### YES

You can receive monthly payments even if you do not usually file taxes




