Bed bugs

We just had the canines come through and do a thorough inspection of the entire building. We will be treating all units that were found to have bed bugs. Please report any bugs that you see so we can treat your apartment immediately. We would like to be bed bug free!!

Electronic locks

For those tenants that have the electronic locks on your apartment, please be aware that when the batteries start to lose power, your lock will flash red. If you see this happen to your lock, please write up a work order and Josh will change the batteries in your lock. This will prevent you from getting locked out of your apartment.

Please don't park in the fire lane

The fire lane is the entry lane to Court Tower from Court Street. It is not meant for people to park their vehicles for more than five minutes. Primarily, it used for the Fire or Police Department to park their vehicles in the case of emergencies. It is also used for residents or their guests to travel on to get to the parking areas of the property. The area directly in front of the building is mainly used for pick up and drop offs. I ask that you follow these guidelines.

The Heat is on!

It is getting to be that time of the year......cold. We would like to advise all residents to change their "system mode" on the temperature control (located on the wall by your laundry closet) to "Heat". We realize that understanding the temperature control may be challenging for some residents. If you feel that you need assistance with this, please fill out a purple work order and provide it to the main office. Josh will respond to your request. Here are the instructions if you wish to do it yourself.

How to turn on your "HEAT" setting

Your best bet for avoiding influenza is to get your flu vaccine.

Two reasons make getting vaccinated against the flu the wise choice:

- 1. It's been proven year after year that you're in better shape to fight off the flu if you get the vaccine.
- 2. By getting vaccinated against the flu, you help protect the people around you just like the COVID-19 vaccine. People can be infected with both flu and the virus that causes COVID-19 at the same time and have symptoms of both influenza and COVID-19.

The flu vaccine like the COVID-19 vaccine takes two weeks to build immunity after getting it. It is usually best for people to get their flu vaccine by the end of October. People can get the flu shot anytime during the flu season. The flu vaccine is your best defense against the flu, but there are additional steps you can take to help yourself from the flu and other viruses. These steps include the following:

- Wash your hands often and thoroughly with soap and water.
- Use an alcohol-based sanitizer on your hands if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth whenever possible.
- Avoid people who are sick.
- Practice good health habits. Get plenty of sleep, exercise regularly, drink plenty of fluids and eat a healthy diet.

The best way to protect yourself and your loved ones against the flu is to get a flu vaccine every flu season. Check with your physician or your local pharmacy to get your flu vaccine.
