Oshkosh Student Bus Passes

GOTRANSIT

STUDENT PASS PROGRAM

EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2023, STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE A NEW FREE GO TRANSIT STUDENT IDENTIFICATION CARD FOR THE 2023 – 2024 SCHOOL YEAR. NO OTHER FORMS OF ID WILL BE VALID FOR THIS PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 6-12.

- Students must show an issued Student Bus Pass each time they board the bus.
- Pass is void if altered or copied.
- Regular fares apply without a valid Student Bus Pass.
- Driver and staff reserve the right to refuse service.
- Failure to follow GO Transit ridership rules may result in suspension of service.

Wednesdays, September 6, 2023 through November 29, 2023 from 11:00 am to 2:00 pm. The last 4 weeks parents will transition to class at Fox Valley Technical College-Appleton Campus while the children remain at B.A.B.E.S., Inc.





A virtual option will be available Wednesdays, September 6, 2023 through November 29, 2023 from 5:00 pm to 7:30 pm. Childcare is not offered with the virtual version.
